### **Vilnius City Tour (3 hours, on foot)**

**Dates: June 3, 2009 at 14:00**

During this 3 hours tour you will understand why Vilnius was added to UNESCO World Heritage list. Such places as Cathedral Square, Presidential Palace, Vilnius University, Gediminas Castle, Town Hall, it's square, St. Ann's and Bernadine's Church, the Gates of Dawn and other places of interest will be visited.

### **Tour Kernave and Trakai (about 6 hours)**

**June 6, 2009 at 14:00**

During this tour you will visit historical capitals of Lithuania - Trakai and Kernavė.

The **Kernavė** Archaeological Site, in eastern Lithuania about 35 km northwest of Vilnius, represents an exceptional testimony to some 10 millennia of human settlements in this region.

**Trakai** is a town built on water. The Peninsular Castle and Island Castle in Trakai were started to be built in the middle of 14th century – and finished at the beginning of the 15th century.

### **Tour to Rumsiskes (about 6 hours)**

**Date: June 5, 2009 at 10:00**

During this tour you will visit Rumsiskes – Lithuanian Open Air Museum.

There you will be able to see all four regions of Lithuania as they looked 100 years ago.

The museum displays about 80 000 exhibits. Some of the houses and implements were actually moved here from their original locations.

### **Discover Lithuania (3 days pre-conference tour)**

**Date: June 1-3, 2009 (Departure: June 1, 09:00; Expected time of arrival: June 3, 17:00)**

During this three day tour you will visit Trakai, Druskininkai, Klaipeda, Vente horn (Ventes Ragas), Rumsiskes

**Trakai** district is one of the most beautiful and historically interesting regions in Lithuania. Trakai Castle of 15th century (in the middle of Lake Galve) is the only insular castle throughout Eastern Europe. **Druskininkai** is the largest resort in Lithuania and it is famous for its old sanatorium treatment traditions: mineral waters and curative mud, which currently are combined with modern technologies and have a great value for health services. You may visit the SPA centre and enjoy relaxing massage, herbal baths or other procedures. **Klaipeda** – the third largest city of Lithuania and seaport. Klaipeda is often called "Gateway to the sea", because it is the main Seaport of Lithuania. Today Klaipeda is a modern city. A network of rectangular streets formed in XII-XV centuries. The city exhibits Neogothic, Eclectic, Neoclassical, and Neorenaissance styles. The tour ends by pleasant and relaxing excursion visiting littoral lighthouses at **Ventes Ragas**. Starting excursion at Minija (Minge) village, between local people called Venice, and going by boat through the rivers Minija, Atmata and the lake Krokų lanka you will spot the most spectacular and scenic places, unspoiled wild nature of Nemunas Delta, which is famous for the variety of birds and wild animals. Continuing this route you will find there Curonian Spit - a sandy spit which separates Baltic Sea from Curonian Lagoon and Ventes Ragas - one of the oldest lighthouse in Lithuania. **Rumsiskes**, an Open-Air Museum of Lithuanian Folk life, located on a 40-acre park. You can see all four regions of Lithuania as they looked 100 years ago. The museum displays about 80 000 exhibits.
